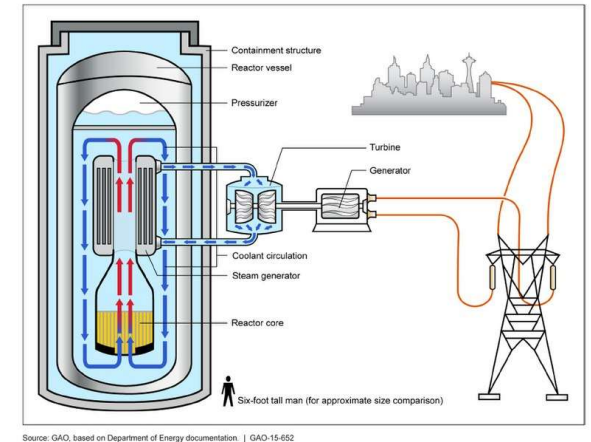
- a. Played active roles in supporting this cause through numerous groups including APAN, Parliamentary Friends of Palestine, AFOPA, Free Palestine Melbourne, Medical Aid for Palestine, Justice for Palestine and several others.
- b. The *Big Ride for Palestine*, Yearly event: Always well-attended by the Palestinian community to welcome the cyclists who rode a total of 750 km to raise money for a refugee camp in Lebanon housing many thousands of Palestinians

- a. A focus is currently on opposition to small modular nuclear reactors, which don't really exist in commercially viable numbers.
- b. In addition, Rosie (with Robin Taubenfeld, Friends of the Earth Brisbane), organizes throughout the year, commemorations of numerous nuclear-related tragic events. These include, Fukushima, Chernobyl, Hiroshima and Nagasaki days, and Maralinga day.
- c. Rosie regularly reports on issues such as the UN Nuclear Treaty, Nuclear waste dumps and their effect upon indigenous peoples.

Report to Just Peace Oct Executive Committee Meeting 2021

The Hiroshima webinar and Maralinga Commemoration Street Action were both well attended. They were a collaborative effort by Women's International League for Peace and Freedom and Just Peace and hopefully this joint organising will continue.

These commemorative events are always used to honour the victims and explain the legacy of the past nuclear disasters and bring to attention present day nuclear issues. For example, the purchase of nuclear-powered submarines, our state and federal protective anti-nuclear legislations under constant (so far unsuccessful) attack and the proposed Kimba nuclear waste dump which is opposed by the local First Nations People.

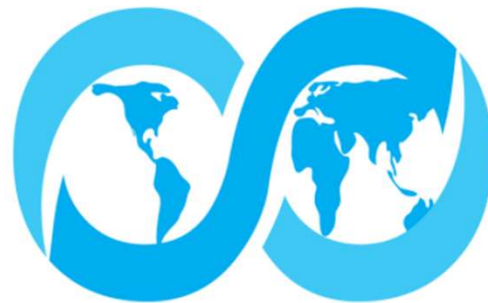
